King's-Universidad Católica de Chile: Students must spend a minimum of one year and a maximum of two years at the partner university.
- Students will usually begin their candidature at their home university and must spend the final six months before completion at the home university.
- Any changes to the travel plan must be agreed with both supervisors and referred to the Joint Academic Committee (via the Centre for Doctoral Studies for the first three partnerships mentioned above) for approval. Changes that result in a student not meeting the above minimum requirements for periods of candidature may result in the student receiving a single PhD, awarded solely by the home institution.
